First-time applicants:

- 1. A one-page, typed description of your future plans, including life goals, the reason(s) for picking the school or college you have chosen, what you plan to study and why.
- 2. A copy of your high school and post high school transcripts. Current high school seniors must submit their transcripts from the previous seven semesters. Undergraduate college students must submit their complete high school transcripts plus all post high school transcripts up to the current time. Graduate students must submit all undergraduate transcripts plus graduate transcripts up to the current time.
- 3. Letters of recommendation from **three** sources. Preferably, one from school, one from employment and one from a non-related church member. Please include addresses and phone numbers. Letters should address **this** scholarship application specifically. Duplicate copies of University Application letters of recommendation are not acceptable.

Return Applicants:

1. An update of your credits and grades.

2. A one or two-page essay about your college experience. (Has it been positive? Are you glad you chose your particular school? If not, will you change schools? What activities have you been involved in? Have you been active in any church-related groups or activities and if so, what? When do you expect to complete your studies? What are your plans after graduation? Essays should be specific to the current year and award.

All Applicants: PLEASE READ GUIDLINES

1. Place all information in a sealed envelope marked "SLAYTON Scholarship," and place envelope in the Office Mailbox or hand deliver to office directly to Jamie Rouster. Applications may also be submitted electronically to: <u>1230finance@howellfumc.com</u> or mailed to First United Methodist Church, Attention: Jamie Rouster, 1230 Bower Street, Howell, MI 48843. Mailed applications must be **received** (not postmarked) by 5/1 of this year in order to be considered.

3. All applicants <u>must</u> be entering a field of study with a Christian basis or entering a field of Ministry. The school does not have to be a Christian college or university.

4. One recipient will receive \$1,000 the first year. A recipient may be eligible for \$500 awards for an additional three years. A recipient student may only receive a total of four years (\$1,000 first year and three additional years each at \$500) and no more than \$2,000 total in awards.

4. The student(s) will be selected by the scholarship committee and the scholarship *custodian,* and the award is to be paid at the beginning of the fall semester only.

5. Applicant may be currently active at Howell FUMC, be on staff, or immediate/extended immediate family member of those previously said. *i.e. child/grandchild.*
